

### NOTICE

- The Pet Fountain is intended to run continuously (always plugged into a wall outlet), as long as the water level is maintained and the Pet Fountain is cleaned regularly. Be sure to check the fountain regularly to help prevent damage to the Pump, as the water may get consumed or evaporate causing the Pump to run dry. Never plug in the Pet Fountain without water filled to the appropriate level.
- Do not attempt repairs on the Pump motor yourself.
- To avoid the possibility of the plug or wall outlet getting wet, the wall outlet should always be above the level of the Pet Fountain.
- If an extension cord is necessary, an extension cord with a proper rating should be used.
- The electrical use of this appliance is 2.5 watts.
- The use of attachments not recommended or sold by the manufacturer may cause an unsafe condition. Do not modify the appliance.
- Do not install or store appliance where it will be exposed to weather or temperatures below 4.5° C.
- Read and observe all important notices listed on the appliance and in the packaging.
- Never wash the filter with soapy water as the soap residue will seep into the filter and cannot be removed. Only rinse the filter with water.
- Use only PetSafe<sup>™</sup> brand authorised replacement filters. If unauthorised filters are used it may void the warranty.





## **Key Definitions**

**Bowl:** The plastic Bowl is the foundation of the Pet Fountain. The bottom of the Bowl features four indentations to run the electrical power cord through.

Tower: Water is pumped up through the ceramic Tower to cycle through the Charcoal Filter and out the top to create a waterfall into the Bowl.

Filter Housing: The plastic Filter Housing consists of a lid and base that holds the Charcoal Filter.

**Rubber Grommet:** The Rubber Grommet comes already installed in the top of the ceramic Tower and forms a seal between the Filter Housing and the Tower.

Rubber Cap: This rubber seal secures the electrical power cord to the inside of the Bowl and prevents leaking.

Charcoal Filter: The 3-layer filter is made with granulated carbon derived from coconut shells. The Charcoal Filter absorbs bad tastes and odours as the water passes through and helps keep the water tasting fresh and more appealing to pets.

Foam Filter: The Foam Filter collects any hair, debris, and pet food before they reach the Pump. It is important to use the Foam Filter as it helps maintain proper Pump function.

Pump: The small aquarium Pump can be partially dismantled for cleaning. THE PUMP IS NOT DISHWASHER SAFE! Remove Pump from the Pet Fountain before cleaning (see "Pump Maintenance" section for detailed instructions). The Pump also features a removable in-line plug for easy attachment and removal.

### Assemble Fountain



- Do not pull on the electrical power cord to remove the plug from the wall outlet.
- To unplug, grasp the plug, not the electrical power cord.

Important: DO NOT RUN DRY - FOR INDOOR USE ONLY. Monitior your Pet Fountain periodically for the first 12 hours to make sure it is running properly.


Note: Rinse all fountain parts with warm water before operating the pet fountain. This will remove any dust or residue that remain in the system from the manufacturing process.


- 1. Carefully remove all the Pet Fountain components from the packaging and set aside prior to assembly.
- 2. As with any electrical device, check the electrical power cord for any tears or damage before use.
- 3. Place the Foam Filter around the Pump by inserting the Pump into the Foam Filter from the top. Make sure the electrical power cord rests on top of the Foam Filter (Fig. 1).






- 4. Position the bowl so that the raised post should be to the right of the square indention (Fig. 2). Place the Pump inside the square indention so the Pump outflow, the circular opening on the top of the Pump, is positioned in the bottom left corner of the square (Fig. 3).
- 5. Press down on the Pump to engage the suction cups. Once the Pump is securely in place, feed the in-line plug of the electrical power cord over and through the raised post and out the notch on the base of the Bowl (**Fig. 4**). There are four notches to choose from.
- 6. Remove the extra slack from the electrical power cord and insert the Rubber Cap into the raised post. Make sure the cord channel on the Rubber Cap is aligned with the electrical power cord, then insert your finger into the Rubber Cap and push all the way down (Fig. 5).
- 7. Fold the top of the Rubber Cap over the raised post to seal off the Bowl (**Fig. 6**).
- 8. Rinse the Charcoal Filter thoroughly under cool water before placing it into the Filter Housing. This will remove any loose charcoal dust, which is harmless. A small amount of charcoal dust may be released for the life of the filter. This is normal and is not harmful to your pet.













- Detach the lid from the base of the Filter Housing. Once rinsed off, place the Charcoal Filter inside the base of the Filter Housing with the larger side of the filter facing down. The filter will only fit inside the base of the Filter Housing one way. If it does not fit, flip it over (Fig. 7).
- 10. Attach the lid to the base of the Filter Housing. Press down until you hear it snap in place.
- Attach the Filter Housing to the Pump by inserting the round notch under the base into the circular opening on top of the Pump (Fig. 8). The opening on top of the Filter Housing should be right next to the sealed raised post (Fig. 9).
- 12. Place the ceramic Tower inside the Bowl. The Rubber Grommet will create a seal between the Filter Housing and the Tower. Carefully lower the Tower until it rests flat (**Fig. 10**).









### Set Up and Add Water

- Place the Pet Fountain in desired location. Do not pick up a full fountain by the Tower piece. To properly pick up the Pet Fountain, use both hands and grip the sidewalls of the Bowl and lift up.
- 2. Fill the Pet Fountain by pouring water directly into the Bowl. Leave at least 1.27 cm of space between the water level and the rim of the Bowl to help control spills and splashing. To protect your floor always use a protective mat, such as a towel or water resistant placemat. This will help protect your floor from splashing or spills caused by your pet.
- Before you plug in the Pet Fountain, make sure the electrical power cord, the adaptor and your hands are completely dry. Connect the in-line plug and make sure no silver is showing, then plug the adaptor into a wall outlet.
- 4. Add water to the Bowl as needed. Never let the water level fall below 2.54 cm from the base of the Bowl or you might risk Pump failure. Replacement Pumps are sold separately by contacting the Customer Care Centre.

## Fountain Disassembly and Cleaning

- Pet Fountain must be cleaned to continue working normally.
- Never wash the filters with soapy water, as the soap residue will seep into the filters and cannot be removed. Only rinse the filters with water.
- Use only PetSafe<sup>™</sup> brand authorised replacement filters. If unauthorised filters are used it may void the warranty.

Note: Use a soft cloth or sponge to prevent scratching the Bowl.

CHARCOAL FILTER: Replace Charcoal Filter every two to four weeks.

• Always rinse the Charcoal Filter prior to use.


- A small amount of charcoal dust may be released for the life of the filter, this is normal and is not harmful to your pet.
- Replace filters more frequently when using the fountain for multiple pets or pets that produce a lot of saliva.


FOAM FILTER: Replace the Foam Filter every 4 to 6 weeks.


If you do not intend to replace the filter at the time of cleaning, rinse the Foam Filter thoroughly with fresh water.

**PET FOUNTAIN:** Clean the Pet Fountain once a week.

- 1. Unplug the Pet Fountain and disconnect the in-line plug (**Fig. 11**).
- Carefully lift the Tower and allow the water to slowly pour back into the Bowl. Once all the water has been emptied into the Bowl, set the Tower aside for cleaning (Fig. 12).
- 3. Take the Tower and turn upside down to remove the Rubber Grommet. Grab the Rubber Grommet from inside and pull straight out, set aside for cleaning (**Fig. 13**).






- Remove the Filter Housing from the Pump by lifting straight up (Fig. 14).
- 5. Open the Filter Housing and remove the Charcoal Filter from inside and dispose. Set the lid and base of the Filter Housing aside for cleaning.
- 6. Remove the Rubber Cap affixed to the raised post by inserting a finger under the lip and pull straight up to remove (**Fig. 15**).
- 7. While securely holding the electrical power cord and the bottom of the Bowl with both hands, pour out the remaining water inside the Bowl into a sink.
- With the in-line plug disconnected and water removed, grab the Pump and lift straight up to disengage the suction cups. Continue pulling the Pump's electrical power cord up and out through the raised post in the center of the Bowl. Once the Pump is completely removed from the Bowl, separate the Foam Filter and set aside for proper cleaning.





- Once the Pet Fountain is completely disassembled, you will have: the Bowl, Tower, two rubber pieces, the Filter Housing, Foam Filter and the Pump.
- 10. Rinse the Foam Filter with water only or replace it with a new one.
- 11. See the "Pump Maintenance" section of this Operating Guide for detailed instructions on how to properly clean your Pump. **DO NOT PLACE PUMP IN DISHWASHER!**
- 12. Hand wash all other fountain parts with warm water and soap. Be sure to rinse thoroughly with fresh water. You can also put the Pet Fountain in the top rack of the dishwasher. If possible, it is recommended that you turn down the heat of the water inside the dishwasher.
- 13. If you have trouble reaching certain spots or hard-to-reach areas, try using a cotton swab or purchase the Drinkwell<sup>™</sup> Cleaning Kit, a 3-Piece Brush Kit. To purchase a Cleaning Kit, visit our website at www.petsafe.net to locate a retailer near you or contact the Customer Care Centre.



### Pump Maintenance

**Important:** Cleaning the Pump is essential to the longevity of the Pet Fountain, as well as the cleanliness of the water. Clean the Pump every two weeks. Warranty may be voided if the Pump's motor is not cleaned regularly.




- Remove the Faceplate by using your thumb and forefinger to gently squeeze on both sides of the Faceplate and pull off. It may be necessary to insert a fingernail into the seam of the Faceplate to pry it off (Fig. 16).
- Next, remove the Intake Plate by placing your fingernail underneath the small lip located on the narrow side of teardrop-shaped Intake Plate (Fig. 17) and pull out to remove.
- 4. Once the Intake Plate is removed, remove the Impeller (white, 3-bladed propeller). The Impeller is held in place by a magnet, simply use a fingernail to get underneath the blade and lift out (**Fig. 18**).
- 5. Once the Pump is completely disassembled, you can clean the parts with warm water and soap. Use a cotton swab or the "motor brush" from the Drinkwell<sup>™</sup> Cleaning Kit to clean inside the Pump's motor cavity and remove any build-up (Fig. 19). For added disinfecting and hard water removal, clean the Pump's motor with a diluted white vinegar solution (20% white vinegar and 80% water). Fig. 19
- 6. Once the parts are clean you can reassemble the Pump for use.
  - a) Replace the Impeller.b) Replace the Intake Plate.
  - c) Replace the Faceplate.

- Place the Foam Filter around the Pump and make sure the electrical power cord rests on top (Fig. 20).
- Position the bowl so that the raised post should be to the right of the square indention. Place the Pump inside the square indention so the Pump outflow, the circular opening on the top of the Pump, is positioned in the bottom left corner of the square (Fig. 21).
- 3. Press down on the Pump to engage the suction cups. Once the Pump is securely in place, feed the in-line plug of the electrical power cord over and through the raised post and out the notch on the base of the Bowl. (**Fig. 22**) There are four notches to choose from.
- 4. Remove the extra slack from the electrical power cord and insert the Rubber Cap into the raised post. Make sure the cord channel on the Rubber Cap is aligned with the electrical power cord, then insert your finger into the Rubber Cap and push all the way down.
- 5. Fold the top of the Rubber Cap over the raised post to seal off the Bowl (**Fig. 23**).
- 6. Rinse a new Charcoal Filter thoroughly under cool water before placing it into the Filter Housing. This will remove any loose and excess charcoal dust, which is harmless.
- 7. Detach the lid from the base of the Filter Housing. Once rinsed off, place the Charcoal Filter inside the base of the Filter Housing with the larger side of the filter facing down. The filter will only fit inside the base of the Filter Housing one way. If it does not fit, flip it over.
- 8. Attach the lid to the base of the Filter Housing. Press down until you hear it snap in place.
- Attach the Filter Housing to the Pump by inserting the round notch under the base into the circular opening on top of the Pump. The opening on top of the Filter Housing should be right next to the sealed raised post (Fig. 24).

### The Pet Fountain and Your Environment


If you live in a humid environment and have problems with mold or algae, soak all fountain parts in a diluted vinegar solution (20% white vinegar and 80% water) for 10 minutes after regular cleaning. Also, pour the diluted vinegar solution into the Pump's motor cavity. If you have hard water, small white mineral deposits may form on or inside the Pump. This can eventually prevent the impeller from turning properly. To avoid replacement or damage to the Pump, please take the following precautions:

- Clean the Pump more frequently.
- Clean the Pump with a diluted vinegar solution weekly.
- Use bottled water instead of tap water.

## General Tips

• When being introduced to the Pet Fountain, your pet may be cautious of this new and unusual object. After beginning operation of your Pet Fountain, simply allow your pet to adjust at his or her own pace. Some pets may take several days or longer to begin use, while others will start right away.

- Your pet may prefer that the Pet Fountain be placed away from their normal feeding area.
- Add ice cubes to the Bowl for refreshing, ice-cold running water.

### Troubleshooting

The answers to these questions should help you solve most problems you may have with the Pet Fountain. If they do not, please contact our Customer Care Centre.

TROUBLESHOOTING		
PROBLEM	SOLUTION	
Pump is not working or the water is not flowing as much as it used to.	<ul> <li>Never let the water in the Bowl get below the minimum fill level. This can cause the Pump to overheat and stop functioning.</li> <li>When refilling the Bowl, make sure to add water before turning the fountain on.</li> <li>Lack of regular cleaning may result in the Pump becoming clogged with pet hair and food debris. The Pump must be cleaned every 2-4 weeks to ensure proper function.</li> <li>A video detailing how to properly clean the Pump is available on our website at www.petsafe.net.</li> <li>Fill the Pet Fountain with water up to the max fill line.</li> </ul>	
Pet Fountain is loud.	<ul> <li>A low humming noise is normal, but it should not be loud. Check the water level. If water level is too low then the Pump will have to work harder causing it to be louder than normal.</li> <li>Unplug the Pet Fountain for 15 seconds. If the noise does not stop when plugged back in, it's possible that some debris is caught on the Impeller. Remove the Pump and clean the Impeller. Try rubbing a small amount of vegetable oil onto the magnetic pin with a cotton swab to lubricate the Impeller.</li> </ul>	
There are black particles in the Bowl.	<ul> <li>This is loose granulated carbon dust from the filter and is completely harmless for your pet to drink. Rinse the filter in cold water before placing it in the Pet Fountain to prevent this.</li> </ul>

The Pet Fountain feels slimy.	<ul> <li>If you have multiple pets or dogs using the Pet Fountain, the slimy feeling may be caused by your pet's saliva. Change the water and clean your fountain more frequently to prevent this.</li> <li>Make sure the Pet Fountain parts are rinsed thoroughly after cleaning the fountain. Soap residue may cause the sliminess.</li> </ul>
The adaptor is warm to the touch.	<ul> <li>Unplug the Pet Fountain and plug it into a surge protector.</li> </ul>
The Pet Fountain is leaking.	<ul> <li>Sometimes water around the Pet Fountain is caused by pets drinking. Some pets are prone to spilling. Watch your pet when he drinks to see if this is the cause. If it is, you can purchase a fountain mat or other water-resistant mat to place under the Pet Fountain.</li> </ul>
The Pet Fountain seems dirty even after cleaning.	<ul> <li>If there is a white chalky substance in the Pet Fountain, your fountain may have a mineral deposit build-up from hard water. To remove these deposits, clean the fountain parts with a 80% water and 20% vinegar solution. Rinse all parts thoroughly afterwards. Use filtered or purified water instead of hard tap water to prevent this.</li> </ul>
