

### **NOTICE**

- The Pet Fountain is intended to run continuously (always plugged into electricity), as
  long as the water level is maintained and the Pet Fountain is cleaned regularly. Be sure
  to check the Pet Fountain regularly to help prevent damage to the Pump, as the water
  may get consumed or evaporate causing the Pump to run dry.
- Do not attempt repairs on the Pump yourself.
- To avoid the possibility of the plug or outlet getting wet, the outlet should always be above the level of the Pet Fountain.
- If an extension cord is necessary, an extension cord with a proper rating should be used.
- The electrical use of this appliance is 2.5 watts.
- Do not use appliance for anything other than intended use. The use of attachments not recommended or sold by the manufacturer may cause an unsafe condition. Do not modify the unit.
- Do not install or store appliance where it will be exposed to weather or temperatures below  $4.5^{\circ}$  C.
- Read and observe all important notices listed on the appliance and in the packaging.
- Never wash the filters with soapy water, as the soap residue will seep into the filters and cannot be removed. Only rinse the filters with water.
- Use only PetSafe® brand authorised replacement filters. If unauthorised filters are used it may void the warranty.





### **Components**



**Note:** Your Pet Fountain will come partially assembled, however, it is a good idea to make sure none of the Pet Fountain pieces have come loose in shipping.



## **Key Definitions**

Bowl: The Bowl is the foundation of the Pet Fountain. The circular Bowl piece can be carried by simply gripping the sidewalls underneath the Bowl.

**Cone:** The Cone acts as the housing for the Pet Fountain components and protects the Pump from curious pets. The Cone acts to reduce the splash and sound of the falling water.

Filter Housing: The Filter Housing slides into the opening at the top of the Cone. It houses the Filter and locks into the Cone by twisting the entire Filter Housing a quarter turn.

Charcoal Filter: The cylindrical Charcoal Filter features a pull-tab at the top and should be placed in the Filter Housing with the pull-tab facing upwards for easy placement and removal.

Foam Filter: The Foam Filter collects hair, debris and pet food before they reach the Pump. It is important to use the Foam Filter as it helps maintain proper Pump function.

**Filter Housing Cap:** The Filter Housing Cap is a screw on cap that attaches to the Filter Housing to keep the Filter in place. It serves as the base piece to attach the Interchangeable Spouts & Flow Control Cap.

**Spout Rings:** The five Interchangeable Spout Rings can be easily changed based upon your pet's preference and can provide up to 5 streams of water for multiple pet households.

Flow Control Cap: The Flow Control Cap is attached to the top of the Pet Fountain and adjusts the flow of water by simply turning the Flow Control Cap left or right. Turn to the right to increase the flow of water. Turn to the left to decrease.


**Pump:** The small submersible aquarium Pump can be dismantled for cleaning. Important: THE PUMP IS NOT DISHWASHER SAFE! Remove Pump from Pet Fountain prior to cleaning (See "Pump Maintenance"). The Pump features an In-Line Plua for easy attachment and removal.


## **Operating Instructions**


Important: DO NOT RUN DRY - FOR INDOOR USE ONLY.


Note: Rinse all fountain parts with warm water before operating the pet fountain. This will remove any dust or residue that remain in the system from the manufacturing process.


- 1. Carefully remove all the Pet Fountain components from the packaging and set aside prior to assembly.
- 2. As with any electrical device, check the electrical Power Cord for any tears, or damage before use.
- 3. Make sure the In-Line Plug is connected (Fig. 1).
- 4. Remove Cone piece by twisting anti-clockwise to unlock the tabs from the Bowl (Fig. 2). Lift up and set aside.
- 5. Check to make sure the Intake Tube is properly inserted (pushed all the way down) into the Pump (Fig. 3).
- 6. Replace Cone and twist clockwise to lock tabs in place (Fig. 4).
- 7. Take the partially assembled Filter Housing and remove the Flow Control Cap by gently lifting straight up - DO NOT TWIST TO REMOVE (Fig. 5). Gently lift up and remove the Spout Ring to access the Filter Housing Cap.
- 8. Unscrew Filter Housing Cap and insert the Charcoal Filter into the Filter Housing with the pull-tab facing up (Fig. 6). The Charcoal Filter will slide easily into place. Next, screw on the Filter Housing Cap (**Fig. 7**).


















Important: Rinse the Charcoal Filter thoroughly under cold water before placing into the housing. This will remove any loose charcoal dust, which is harmless to your pet. A small amount of charcoal dust may be gradually released for the life of the Filter. This is normal and not harmful to your pet.

- Align the side grooves of the Filter Housing with the inner notches of the Cone opening. The Filter Housing should slide easily into place. Turn Filter Housing a quarter turn to the right (clockwise) until it locks in place (Fig. 8).
- 10. Select one of the five interchangeable Spout Rings based upon your personal preference or your pet's. Place the chosen Spout Ring on top of Filter Housing Cap and gently press down evenly to secure in place (Fig. 9).
- 11. Align Flow Control Cap with the raised notches (**Fig. 10**) on the Filter Housing Cap. Press down gently and the cap will snap into place. With the Flow Control Cap, you will be able to easily adjust the flow intensity of the water. Turn the cap to the right to increase the flow and turn to the left to decrease.


**Important:** If you notice a decrease in the flow of the water that is not corrected by turning the Flow Control Cap toward max this may be an indication of a clogged and dirty Filter and/or the need to rinse and clean the Filter Housing. Consult the "Filters and Pet Fountain Cleaning" section of this Operating Guide for details on cleaning and maintaining your Pet Fountain.

- 12. Place Pet Fountain in desired location. Do not pick up a full Pet Fountain by the Cone piece. To properly pick up the Pet Fountain, use both hands and grip the sidewalls of the Pet Fountain Bowl and lift. **Important:** To take care of your floors, always use a protective mat, such as a towel or place mat. This will help protect your floor from any water that may splash out from your pet's use of the Pet Fountain.
- 13. Fill the Pet Fountain Bowl with water. Make sure the water level is at least to the MIN (minimum) fill line so the Pump does not run dry. This will prime the Pump for use. Do not fill the Pet Fountain past the MAX (maximum) fill line.
- 14. Before you plug in the Pet Fountain make sure the Power Cord and your hands are dry. Plug the Pet Fountain in to an electrical outlet.
- 15. Add water as needed. Never let the water level fall lower than the MIN (minimum) fill line (approx. 2.5 cm above the bottom of the Bowl, Fig. 11) or the Pump may fail. Replacement Pumps are sold separately by calling a Customer Care Centre. Visit www.petsafe.net for a telephone listing of the Customer Care Centre near you.









## Filters and Pet Fountain Cleaning FILTER SYSTEM

The Pet Fountain is equipped with two types of filters that should be replaced on a regular basis. The Charcoal Filter removes bad tastes and odours, keeping water fresh. The Foam Filter collects hair, debris and pet food and prevents them from reaching the Pump, providing optimal filtration. The filters together will keep the Pump cleaner and provide fresher water to your pet.



**Charcoal Filter:** Filters should be changed every two to four weeks. Replace filters more frequently when using the Pet Fountain for multiple pets or pets that produce a lot of saliva. **Important:** Always rinse the Charcoal Filter prior to use. A small amount of charcoal dust may be released for the life of the filter, this is normal and is not harmful to your pet.



Foam Filter: Replace the Foam Filter every one to two months, depending on the location of the Pet Fountain and the number of pets using it. If you do not intend to replace the filter at the time of cleaning, rinse the Foam Filter thoroughly with fresh water.

Filters are an added feature of the Pet Fountain. Using the filters is not required for normal operation. However, when used properly and changed regularly, the filters help keep the water cleaner and fresher, while extending the life of your Pet Fountain. Filters may be rinsed out when the Pet Fountain is cleaned



- Never wash the filters with soapy water, as the soap residue will seep into the filters and cannot be removed. Only rinse the filters
- Use only PetSafe® brand authorised replacement filters. If unauthorised filters are used it may void the warranty.


### PET FOUNTAIN

Important: Clean Pet Fountain once a week.


The Pet Fountain must be cleaned on a regular basis to continue working normally.


- 1. Unplug Pet Fountain from electrical source and disconnect the In-Line Plug from the Pump (Fig. 12).
- 2. Remove the Flow Control Cap and Spout Ring.
- 3. Remove the Filter Housing by twisting the Filter Housing Cap anti-clockwise to the unlock position. Lift directly up and set aside.












7. Remove the Intake Tube by lifting up on the Intake Tube Holder to free the Intake Tube from the Pump (Fig. 15 & 16). This will allow you to remove the Pump. The Intake Tube can then be pulled from the Intake Tube holder.







- 8. Remove the Foam Filter from the Pump. Clean away any hair, debris or pet food that may have accumulated on the Faceplate of the Pump (See "Pump Maintenance" section for detailed cleaning instructions for the Pump).
- 9. Once the Pet Fountain is completely disassembled you will have 8 plastic parts.
- 10. Clean the plastic Pet Fountain parts with warm water and soap. You can also put the Pet Fountain in the top rack of the dishwasher. Remove the Pump before placing the Pet Fountain in the dishwasher. DO NOT PLACE PUMP IN DISHWASHER! If possible, it is recommended that you turn down the heat of the water inside the dishwasher.
- 11. If you have trouble reaching certain spots or hard-to-reach corners, try using a cotton swab or purchase the Drinkwell® Cleaning Kit, a 3-Piece Brush Kit. ## **Pump Maintenance**


**Important:** Cleaning the Pump is essential to the longevity of the Pet Fountain as well as the cleanliness of the water. Clean the Pump at least every two weeks. Warranty may be voided if the Pump is not cleaned regularly.



- 1. Remove Pump from the Pet Fountain as explained in the "Filters and Pet Fountain Cleaning" section of this Operating Guide.
- Once the Pump is out of the Pet Fountain, with your thumb and forefinger, gently squeeze on either side of the Faceplate, and pull it off. It may be necessary to insert a fingernail into the seam of the Faceplate to pry it off (Fig. 17).




- Next remove the Intake Plate by placing your fingernail under the small lip located on the narrow side of teardrop-shaped Intake Plate Pull-Tab and pull out to remove (Fig. 18).
- 4. Once the Intake Plate is removed you can also remove the Impeller (white, 3-bladed propeller) which is held in place magnetically. To remove the Impeller, insert a fingernail or other slim object underneath the plastic blade and lift out of Pump (Fig. 19).





5. Once the Pump is disassembled you can clean the parts with warm soap and water. Use a cotton swab or the "motor" brush from the Drinkwell® Cleaning Kit to get into the Pump's motor cavity and remove any build-up (Fig. 20). For added disinfecting and hard water removal, clean the Pump's motor cavity with a diluted vinegar solution (20% white vinegar & 80% water). Be sure to rinse thoroughly with fresh water.





- 6. Once the parts are clean you can reassemble the Pump for use.
  - a) Replace the Impeller.
  - b) Replace the Intake Plate.
  - c) Replace the Faceplate.


## **Pet Fountain Reassembly**


- Place the Foam Filter around the Pump. Make sure the electrical Power Cord runs over the top of the Foam Filter, not underneath it, as this will keep the Foam Filter in place.
- 2. With the Foam Filter securely around the Pump, replace the Pump into its location between the four posts in the centre of the Bowl. Be sure to position the circular


opening on the top of the Pump next to the Cord Pass-Through in the Bowl. Gently push down to engage the suction cups.























Locked 6. Screw on Filter Housing Cap and slide the Filter Housing into place in the hole at the top of the Cone. Turn Filter Housing a quarter turn to the right (clockwise) to lock in place.

5. Align the three notches around

the Cone with the corresponding tabs in the bowl. Next, turn the Cone piece to the right (clockwise) to lock tabs into place (Fig. 25 & 26).



8. Replace the Flow Control Cap by aligning it with the notches on the Filter Housing Cap. Gently push down to secure in place (Fig. 27).



9. Place Pet Fountain in desired location. Important: To take care of your floors, always use a protective mat, such as a towel or place mat. This will help protect your floor from any water that may splash out from your pet's use of the Pet Fountain.

- 10. Fill the Pet Fountain Bowl with water, Make sure the water level is at least to the MIN (minimum) fill line so the Pump does not run dry. Do not fill the Pet Fountain past the MAX (maximum) fill line.
- 11. Make sure the electrical Power Cord, the Adaptor and your hands are completely dry before you plug the Pet Fountain into an electrical outlet. Connect the Inline Plug and make sure no silver is showing, then plug the Adaptor into an electrical outlet.

### The Pet Fountain and Your Environment

If you live in a humid environment and have problems with mold or algae, soak all fountain parts in a diluted vinegar solution (20% White Vinegar and 80% Water) for 10 minutes after regular cleaning. Also, pour the diluted vinegar solution into the Pump's motor cavity.

If you have hard water, small white mineral deposits may form on or inside the Pump. This can eventually prevent the Impeller from turning properly. To avoid replacement or damage to the Pump, please take the following precautions:

- Clean the Pump more frequently.
- Clean the Pump with a diluted vinegar solution weekly.
- Use bottled water instead of tap water.

## Tips On Use

- When being introduced to the Pet Fountain, your pet may be cautious of this new
  and unusual object. After beginning operation of your Pet Fountain, simply allow your
  pet to adjust at his or her own pace. Some pets may take several days or longer to
  begin use, while others will start right away.
- Your pet may prefer that the Pet Fountain be placed away from their normal feeding area. Try placing it in another location, such as a different area of the kitchen or in a bathroom or utility room.
- Add ice cubes to the bowl for refreshing, ice-cold running water!

## **Troubleshooting**

The answers to these questions should help you solve most problems you may have with the Pet Fountain. If they do not, please contact our Customer Care Centre.

TROUBLESHOOTING		
PROBLEM	SOLUTION	
Pump is not working or the water is not flowing as much as it used to.	<ul> <li>Never let the water in the bowl get below the minimum fill level. This can cause the pump to overheat and stop functioning.</li> <li>When refilling the bowl, make sure to add water before turning the pet fountain on.</li> <li>Lack of regular cleaning may result in the pump becoming clogged with pet hair and food debris. The pump must be cleaned every 2-4 weeks to ensure proper function.</li> <li>Fill the pet fountain with water up to the max fill line.</li> </ul>	
Pet Fountain is loud.	<ul> <li>A low humming noise is normal, but it should not be loud. Check the water level. If water level is too low then the pump will have to work harder causing it to be louder than normal.</li> <li>Unplug the pet fountain for 15 seconds. If the noise does not stop when plugged back in, it's possible that some debris is caught on the impeller. Remove the pump and clean the impeller. Try rubbing a small amount of vegetable oil onto the magnetic pin with a cotton swab to lubricate the impeller.</li> </ul>	
There are black particles in the bowl.	This is loose granulated charcoal dust from the filter and is completely harmless for your pet to drink.     Rinse the charcoal filter in cold water before placing it in the pet fountain to prevent this.	

The pet fountain feels slimy.	<ul> <li>If you have multiple pets or dogs using the pet fountain, the slimy feeling may be caused by your pet's saliva. Change the water and clean your fountain more frequently to prevent this.</li> <li>Make sure the pet fountain parts are rinsed thoroughly after cleaning the fountain. Soap residue may cause the sliminess.</li> </ul>
The power adaptor is warm to the touch.	Unplug the pet fountain and plug it into a surge protector.
The pet fountain is leaking.	Sometimes water around the pet fountain is caused by pets drinking. Some pets are prone to spilling. Watch your pet when he drinks to see if this is the cause. If it is, you can purchase a pet fountain mat or other water-resistant mat to place under the pet fountain.
The pet fountain seems dirty even after cleaning.	If there is a white chalky substance in the pet fountain, your fountain may have a mineral deposit build-up from hard water. To remove these deposits, clean the fountain parts with a 80% water and 20% vinegar solution. Rinse all parts thoroughly afterwards. Use filtered or purified water instead of hard tap water to prevent this.
